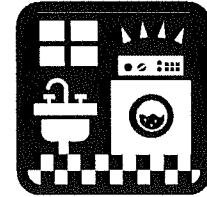
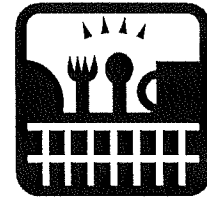

- ✓ Purchase a qualifying Energy Star rated high efficiency washer.
- ✓ Obtain an application package & qualifying rules.
- ✓ Complete an application, enclose a copy of your receipt, and mail it to:

Retain a copy of the completed application for your records. The Sales Receipt for washers must be dated after February 1, 2005; and March 1, 2006 for dishwashers, with the name of the seller clearly indicated. Your rebate will be mailed to you within 60-days after receipt and verification. Manchester Water District may take such action as is reasonably necessary to verify the accuracy of statements made in the application prior to payment of rebate.

This offer is valid for a residential \$50 clothes washer and \$25 dishwasher rebate for machines purchased after February 1, 2005 and March 1, 2006 respectively. Funds for rebates are limited and available on a first-come first-served basis, limit one rebate per household. The District will review your rebate application and determine if the installed product(s) qualify for the rebate. By signing below you acknowledge that the residential clothes and/or dish washer purchased is on the District qualified model list, and the appliance is installed at a residence served by the District water system. District may inspect these products for conformity to program requirements. The Manchester Water District makes no implied or expressed warranties or representations with regard to these products or water/energy savings from these installations. Rebate offer is dependent on available funds and expires when funds are exhausted. The Board of Commissioners in their sole discretion retain the ability to extend, modify, or cancel the Water Conservation Rebate Program.

Water Conservation Rebate Program  
Resolution No. 2005-01 & 2006-03 — Eligibility & Guidelines**

- Customer shall be in good standing in payment of all District billings and in compliance with all duly enacted regulations at time of application, and when the machine was purchased.
- Customer shall be a residential customer of the District (apartments, condominiums, commercial establishments, or multiple duplexes on a single water meter do not currently qualify).
- The machine used shall be permanently located in a qualifying residence within the District's service area.
- The clothes washer shall have been purchased on or after February 1, 2005 and the dishwasher after March 1, 2006.
- The machine purchased must appear on the preferred ENERGY STAR list, as periodically revised.
- Customer shall provide proof of purchase in the form of a sales receipt or purchase invoice.
- Customer shall allow for physical inspection of the new machine by a District representative to confirm the make and model of the washing machine.
- Rebate amount is currently established at \$50 per household for clothes washers and \$25 per household for dishwashers.

**Notes:**

1. Ventless washer/dryer units are NOT on this list because they lose some or all of their water savings when water is used during the "condensing" drying cycle.
2. Machines in each category must meet Saving Water Partnership criteria for both energy and water.
